

Château Beaubourg

Côtes de Bourg

A wine typical of the appellation, round and supple with ripe black fruit notes intertwined with licorice notes and mellow tanins.

LOCATION: Located in the district of Villeneuve, next to Bourg, the estate has been in the hands of Mr Chan Sec Theong since 1984.

VINEYARD AREA : 7 hectares

SOIL : Clayey-sandy-silty soil with a calcareous subsoil.

GRAPE VARIETALS: 70 % Merlot, 26 % Cabernet Sauvignon,
2 % Cabernet Franc, 2 % Malbec

Average age of the vines: 26 years-old

Average plantation density: 4 427 stocks/ha

CULTURAL METHODS AND HARVESTING: Ploughing with no weed-killer, manual deleafing

VINIFICATION: Total destemming, traditional vinification in stainless steel vats, addition of yeasts and oak chips. Post-fermentation maceration during 2 weeks.

AGEING: Ageing in stainless steel vats

YEARLY PRODUCTION : 370 hectolitres – 50,000 bottles
