

Château Beauregard Ducasse Cuvée Albert Duran Graves red

When young, it is a strong and tannic wine. When ageing it becomes very fine with a nice bouquet. Very good for ageing.

LOCATION: Estate located in Mazeres at the south of Langon.

Mr Perromat, current owner and very good winemaker, has been managing it since 1981 but the estate has been the property of his family in law Mr Jean Duran for 4 or 5 generations.

The estate is located on the highest gravelly hill (112 m) and benefits from an outstanding shining

VINEYARD AREA: 10 hectares.

SOIL: Gravelly on the hill with clayey-calcareous areas on the slopes- A small iron-pan layer in the sub-soil.

GRAPE VARIETIES: 50 % Merlot, 40 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petit Verdot

Age of the vines: 15-25

HARVESTING: Hand picking and mechanical harvesting at full maturity.

WINEMAKING: Traditional winemaking in stainless steel vats with temperature monitoring. Long maceration (25 to 35 days).

AGEING: The whole harvest ages in new oak casks and casks of 1 and 2 wines during 12 months

PRODUCTION: 36 000 bottles per year
