

Château Lamanieu

Graves red

*A wine typical from the Graves, supple, deep-coloured, with red fruits and mineral aromas.
To drink with red meat, dishes cooked in a sauce and cheese.*

LOCATION: Mazères (south of Langon). The estate has been owned by the family Perromat since the early 20th century. Ch. Lamanieu is the second wine of Ch. Beaugard Ducasse

VINEYARD AREA: 20 hectares

SOIL : Stony and sandy with clay and limestone on the slopes on an iron hard pan subsoil

GRAPE VARIETIES: 50 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 45 % Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc

Comes from the younger vines

HARVESTING: Hand-picking at full ripeness

WINEMAKING: Traditional methods in stainless steel vats. The maceration lasts about 20 days

AGEING: In stainless steel vats during 6 months

PRODUCTION: 120,000 bottles per year
