

Château Lamothe de Bertineau

Lalande de Pomerol

*A very « Merlot » wine, well-balanced, elegant and pleasant with a present but well-integrated oak.
To enjoy over poultry with mushroom, pork and mild cheeses like Brie,
Saint-Nectaire, and young cheddar*

LOCATION: Family-owned estate dating back the early 20th century, and owned by Mr Larnaudie. The estate is located in the district of Neac.

VINEYARD AREA : 10 hectares

SOIL : Sandy-gravelly

GRAPE VARIETALS : 80 % Merlot, 20 % Cabernet franc

AVERAGE AGE OF THE VINES: 30

HARVESTING: Mechanical harvesting at full ripeness

VINIFICATION: Traditional vinification in thermo-regulated stainless-steel vats with long maceration

AGEING: In vats and oak barrels

ANNUAL PRODUCTION: About 65,000 bottles
