

# Château du Glana

## Saint Julien

*A well-balanced, silky, complex and elegant wine with oodles of fruit  
And a good ageing potential.  
To taste at 17°C on red meats, game and cheeses*

**LOCATION** : On the road of the great wines along the Gironde estuary between the districts of Beychevelle and Saint Julien and facing the Château Ducru Beaucaillou. The castle was built in 1870 by Mr Nadeau, architect of Blaye; the vineyard is a grouping of several parcels coming from Château Saint Pierre. In 1943, Mr Gabriel Meffre bought the Château du Glana and increase the area to 43 ha acquiring some parcels of Château Lagrange. Jean Paul Meffre, helped by his two young sons manages now the estate. This estate has known an unprecedented qualitative progression since 1999. The owner is advised by Professor Denis Dubourdieu.

**VINEYARD AREA** : 43 hectares

**SOIL** : Big deep Gravel.

**GRAPE VARIETIES**: 67% Cabernet Sauvignon - 27% Merlot - 6% Cabernet Franc

Average age of the Vineyard: 21

**HARVESTING** : Green harvest, leaf-removal, desbudding. Integrated agriculture. Hand-picking and mechanical harvest. Double-sorting out.

**WINEMAKING** : Cold prefermentary maceration Traditional winemaking with a 3-week-vatting in cement vats with temperature monitoring.

**AGEING** : In oak barrels of which 45% are new during 12 months.

**PRODUCTION** : 115 000 bottles.
