

Château Du Haut Plateau

Montagne Saint Emilion

A well-balanced, round and supple wine with loads of fruit (plums, black fruit) and mellow tannins.

LOCATION: Perched on the slopes next to Château Montaguillon, on a superb soil fully oriented south in Montagne, the Château Haut Plateau has belonged to the family Amart, also owner of Ch. Montaguillon, for 3 generations.

VINEYARD AREA =: 15 hectares

SOIL: Clayey slopes

GRAPE VARIETALS: 70 % Merlot, 20 % Cabernet Franc, 10 % Cabernet Sauvignon

HARVESTING : Mechanical harvests

VINIFICATION: Traditional vinification in stainless steel vats with a 3-week maceration.

AGEING: Ageing in stainless steel vats for 12 months

YEARLY PRODUCTION: 95 000 bottles
