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Château La Roche Mézières Castillon Côtes de Bordeaux

Beautiful deep garnet color.

Pleasant bouquet with aromas of dry plums, cherries and leather.

On the palate, the wine is sturdy but supple, round and well-balanced with a long and fruity finish.

This wine will age well for 10 years.

Would be ideal with white meats and steaks and mild cheeses like Saint Nectaire.

HISTORY AND LOCATION: In the district of Castillon. Six generations of winegrowers have successively run the estate. The Augereau family perpetuates the tradition.

VINEYARD AREA : 11 hectares.

SOIL: Clayey-calcareous and gravelly slopes.

GRAPE VARIETALS: 70 % Merlot - 25 % Cabernet Sauvignon - 5 % Cabernet Franc.

Average age of the vineyard: 40

VINIFICATION: Traditional in thermo-regulated stainless steel vats.

Long maceration.

AGEING: The wine is partially aged in barrels.
